- Collaborate with Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA) and team to design effective behavior intervention plans
- Implement behavior plans as written
- Take behavior and skill acquisition data daily/graph data daily
- Share data with team weekly
- Communicate professionally and openly with team to support best outcome for all students
- Write progress reports quarterly
- Use Safe Crisis Management (SCM) techniques when required
- Participate in on-going training opportunities
- Other duties as assigned

- Have earned a minimum of a bachelor's degree or be working toward a Bachelor's Degree
- Have experience and some level of comfort working with individuals who may exhibit aggressive, disruptive, and/ or self-injurious behavior.
