### **Duties Include:**

- Participating as a member of the program team to provide initial and ongoing educational evaluations and assessments for students
- Utilizing professional knowledge and skills to develop and write goals to assist students with educational challenges
- Providing direct instruction to staff and students in the areas of curriculum-based skills
- Planning and conducting activities for a balanced program of instruction that provides students with a variety of learning opportunities
- Preparing materials and maintaining a safe classroom environment
- Establishing clear objectives for students' daily activities
- Ensuring proper documentation is maintained and filed in accordance with the IEP (i.e., client files, case records, IEP requirements, etc.)
- Assisting with the implementation of the students' individualized programs with the educational assistant and other staff as needed
- Participating with other key staff as a team
- Attending required trainings and meetings as assigned (i.e., IEP meetings/meetings with families)
- Following the written policies and procedures as documented and keeping administration updated on staff schedule changes
