## Occupational Therapist (OT)

### Qualifications:

- Completion of a Master's Degree in Occupational Therapy or eligible for licensure in Ohio
- Demonstrates effective communication and interpersonal skills and the ability to collaborate with teams.
- Demonstrates leadership, management, and organizational skills
- Demonstrates sensitivity to the various cultural and socioeconomic characteristics of CCA students and staff

### Duties:

- Participates as a member of the program team to provide initial and ongoing occupational therapy evaluations for students
- Utilizes professional knowledge/skills as a member of the program team to develop goals to assist clients/students with motor/sensory challenges that impede daily living
- Provides direct, indirect, and group occupational therapy to students to support their behavioral and educational programs
- Develops and prepares materials as needed to support students' program goals
- Ensure proper documentation is maintained and filed according to students' educational and behavior plans (i.e., IEPs, progress reports, etc.)
- Participates with other key staff
- Attends required meetings and trainings as assigned
- Stays updated on current research and methodologies for students
- Follows the written policies and procedures as documented and keeps administration updated on staff schedule changes
- Manages and supervises occupational therapist assistants (COTA) and students/interns
- Maintains licensure requirements
- Maintains CCA and student confidentiality
- Other duties as assigned by Management
